

InSights Writing Grants: Call for Proposals 2019

InSights Writing Grants fund Majority World scholars to conduct research, write books and articles, and publish their work in service to the Church and society. In particular, we seek research that contributes to the study of Majority World theological education.

These grants serve as one-time supplemental support for academic writing and research projects. We will give preference to applications that target one facet of a project.

Project authors will:

- Produce a publication – a book, article, or edited collection
- Write a scholarly article for the *InSights Journal for Global Theological Education* about their project. How does their writing contribute to understandings and practices of theological education in the Majority World?

We especially seek authors who are writing on the following topics:

- Theological education in Muslim-majority contexts
- Women in theological leadership
- The Church challenging political, social, cultural, and/or spiritual corruption
- Online theological education and spiritual formation

To apply, please follow these directions:

- Email a 1-page, single-spaced proposal to erhunter@scholarleaders.org with the subject line “InSights Writing Grant Proposal.”
- Attach your CV to the email as a separate document from the proposal.
- Ask two references to send letters of recommendation to the email address above.
 - **One** should come from a leader within the applicant’s own institution and affirm the project.
 - The **second** should come from a colleague at another institution who can speak to the project’s broader value.

Only successful proposals will receive follow-up communication.
